Since that time, WMU has helped lead Southern Baptist churches to give over \$6 billion through the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering and Lottie Moon Christmas Offering.

In **April**, we will return to Connie Maxwell to love and minister to the kids and staff with an innovative camp to build deeper connections with Christ. We will also serve alongside our partner church in North Charleston, SC, in April and possibly again in the fall.

Later in the year, there will be opportunities to minister to persecuted Christians in Bangkok, Thailand, pray and possibly help with a new church plant in St. George, Utah, serve alongside our partner church in Boston, MA., and a return trip to Panama where we will be working with IMB missionaries to minister to the homeless, sick, poor, and help local churches connect with their community.

Many served at United Christian Ministries in December. Mt. Airy wants to build on the partnership by having volunteers serve throughout the year as intake personnel and assist in other areas. We are also planning to work with SHINE to serve food to the homeless.

We also need more volunteers to serve as greeters, on the safety team, and at the Next Steps table. These positions rotate so that it would be approximately once every six weeks.
