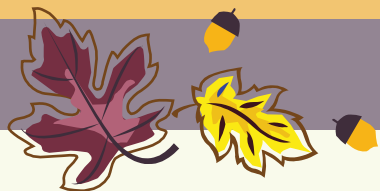
Men's & Ladies' Ministry Events
