Summer Camp Info for Kids

RA Alpha Camp - Camp McCall; June 9-11 (1st - 5th gr. boys). Cost: \$80 for members or children of church members; \$155 for adults or non-members. Must be accompanied by a male relative.

RA Crusader Camp - Camp McCall; June 12-16 (4th - 5th gr. boys). Cost: \$155 for members or children of members; \$310 for non-members.

GA Week Camp - Camp La Vida; June 12-16 (3rd - 6th gr. girls). Cost: \$140 for members or children of church members; \$275 for non-members.
