Tips for Reading Proverbs

Here are three things to know that will help you read Proverbs:

1. PROVERBS ARE PRINCIPLES, NOT PROMISES

The author is not intending to communicate an unbreakable promise from God, but rather a general principle of the best way to live, and a description of how that typically results in a flourishing life.

2. FOCUS ON VERSES, NOT ON THE CHAPTER

Don't try to understand EVERYTHING on your first read. Just pick up one or two verses that stand out to you and reflect on them each day. Consider underlining them in your Bible, writing them in your journal, or posting them on your social media accounts so that others can reflect on the verses with you.

3. TAKE YOUR TIME

Proverbs is not a book that you can rush through. Many of the sayings in the book cause you to stop and think and this is exactly what you should do. Someone said, "Read a little and think a lot as you read through the Proverbs." If you do this I believe it will allow the truth of the Scriptures to penetrate your heart and shape your life.
